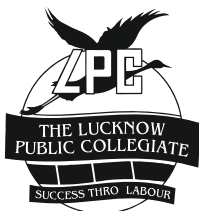

1. Background

The first Long Hours "Day Boarding" School in Lucknow, "The Lucknow Public Collegiate", a co-educational institution is the outcome of our detailed and sustained research of the present day problems of children and parents in the direction of education. The institution started its first academic session in April, 1986. The overwhelming co-operation from the parents and their confidence in this kind of special approach to learning and teaching had given us great encouragement to establish this institution and to serve the people of Lucknow, the capital of Uttar Pradesh.

The first long hours Day Boarding School in Lucknow "The Lucknow Public Collegiate", is successfully functioning at 3, Jopling Road, Lucknow from Nursery to Class XII and is affiliated to C.I.S.C.E., Delhi. Its branch at Ruchi Khand I, Sharda Nagar, Lucknow started functioning from 2nd April 1997 from Class Nur. to Class XII and is affiliated to C.B.S.E., Delhi.

2. Objective

The main objectives of this institution are :-

- to provide individual attention to every student so that he/she becomes independent and develops interest in self studies.
- to help the students sustain the rich heritage of our Country and at the same time make them compete with others.
- to bring out the best of their personality and to make them multifaceted, mature and responsible citizens of the world.

3. Educational Philosophy of the Institution

We carried out a comprehensive research on the philosophy of Public Education existing in India and the difficulties faced by the the students and parents of such schools. The philosophy of education is thus based on the findings of our own research.

LPC does not believe in the system of promotion based on donation and private tuitions, rather it assures each parent/guardian, of the complete responsibility of the child's education, his/her manners and all around development of his/her personality.

4. In The Day Boarding and Boarding

The periods are of a duration closer to an hour. Besides covering the syllabus, the teachers have sufficient time to know the student's problems,

teach a new lesson, complete the assignment in the classroom itself and revise it. Since the teachers can cater to the individual needs of the children, they can approach him/her with their problems. Our past experience has proved that LPC can admit children regardless of their previous medium of instruction and make them worthy of the higher class.

The child remains in the academic atmosphere of the LPC for full eight hours. He learns his lessons, does his assignments and revision under the guidance of his teachers and no work is left to be done at home.

The LPC adheres to the view that home tutorials are not only insufficient but also the unscientific approach of the tutors irrespective of the individual's need causes confusion in the tender minds of the children. The LPC, therefore, completely rejects the system of home tutorials especially in lower classes. The efforts of LPC is to make learning playful and enjoyable so that when the children go back home their mind is free. They can spend quality time with their parents without causing any kind of inconvenience to them.

Despite the fact that our children come from different cultural backgrounds & social class, the LPC invariably exposes them to the living conditions of various social groups like those who live in slums and are below poverty line. Our aim is to sensitize and educate them in a manner that they are prepared to undertake the responsibility of the underprivileged when they are called upon to do so. Besides, this exposure also instills in them the dignity of manual labour and a sense of social service.

Thus it is envisaged that with this kind of educational background, the LPC child not only aspires for the higher echelon jobs but also remains down to earth, practical and aware of the average Indian's aspirations and conditions of life.

Since, this inter alia depends upon the mental framework of a child, all of them are subjected to I.Q. rating, tolerance, aptitude and adaptability tests.

The Collegiate does not impart any religious instructions, as it believes that religion is something personal. Responsibility of religious education is of the home.

It is desirable that the parents tell their wards that the LPC educational system is the best. They should avoid making criticism of it and expressing their desire to give them something better than that. The LPC exists for their betterment and the parents are requested to keep in constant touch with the teachers and the Principal of the institution regarding the progress of their wards as well as regarding the interest of other children and the institution as a whole.

It is collective responsibility of the LPC family i.e., the children, the parents, the LPC teachers, its Principal and the non-teaching personnel to ensure all around development of each LPC child.

Why Long Hours Day Boarding?

Simple reasoning will reveal that the children of a particular age group require more children of the same age group to interact and develop. This opportunity cannot be provided by the parents of any income-group. A school is the only answer to this problem. Our system incorporates the best of a residential school and a day school at a minimum cost.

Instead of children from affluent families loitering aimlessly, they can be usefully engaged at Lucknow Public Collegiate (LPC) where they will have privilege of exploiting their hidden potentials through enjoyable, constructive, useful and productive activities.

5. Educational system

- (a) The medium of instruction is English and the school at Jopling Road is affiliated with the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi.

The ICSE syllabus is comprehensive English, Hindi and Social Studies are compulsory subjects with Computer Science, Mathematics, Science, Economics and Commerce as other elective subjects. The ICSE Examination is at the end of class X. The ISC Examination is at the end of standard XII. Both examinations are held in Feb/March.

- (b) The School at Sharda Nagar is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi, which is one of the two recognized and approved All India Boards of Secondary Education. The Board administers two examinations.

- i) All India Secondary School Examination at the end of Standard X.
- ii) The Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination at the end of Standard XII. Both examinations are held in Feb/March.

The LPC uses the latest educational techniques, such as, Computer Aided Teaching, Personal Address System, V.H.S. video System/OHP etc.

Smart Class

In keeping with our commitment to innovation and development in teaching methods, we have introduced the smart class program which is part of the growing international emphasis on the harnessing of the immense potential of technology for education in schools.

The program enables teachers to use digital resources such as graphics, animations, 3D images and video clips in addition to traditional teaching methodologies. The resulting multi-sensory learning experience addresses different learning styles and contributes to improved academic performance.

6. Courses of Studies

The Medium of Instruction is English.

- (1) Provisional Admission to Class Xth :

7. Food

The LPC has discovered that the so called tiffin boxes in use contain incomplete and/or unbalanced meals. The school, therefore, provides fruits, biscuits at 10:00 a.m., a five course vegetarian lunch in the afternoon and milk/porridge at 4:00 p.m. so that the children have a sound mind in a sound body. These meals are balanced according to the nutrition and calories required by the child.

The meals are prepared under the supervision of an experienced catering manager who scrutinises all food items before selection.

The school envisages that with the co-operation of parents, it can inculcate good eating habits in the students since the students and teachers including the head of the institution share the meal at the same table. The LPC child of standard four (8+years) unconsciously learns table manners unknown even to many graduates.

Parents/guardians are requested not to give money to their wards so that the institutions will be successful in preventing the students from consuming unhygienic stuff.

8. Health

Periodical medical check-ups which are necessary for the child's physical development, form part of the school activity to ascertain proper growth and health. A medical officer carries out these check-ups once in every three months. In case of any emergency the LPC has set up a well equipped infirmary.

9. Career Guidance Cell

Aims at mentoring the students till they leave the school & helping them to cope with a competitive world & deadline through adequate & timely information.

Counsellors

We have trained counsellor responsible for working with students who need help manage their behaviour, Keeping up academically or planning planning for the future.

Counsellor works with administration, teachers & parents to develop a comfortable, school environment free of bullying , illegal activities & to help help guide the students academic, behavioral & social growth.

10. Yoga

A trained yoga expert is there to take regular yoga classes, Yoga will help help students learn how to use their bodies in a healthy way- manage stress through (correct) breathing, meditation and healthy movement. It will not only build concentration but also help to increase their confidence & positive self image.

11. Games, Sports and Hobbies

Emphasis is laid on regular exercise and physical fitness of each child. This programme is run under the basketball, volleyball, football, badminton, Table Tennis, Hockey, & boxing are the choices available to students.

The Collegiate includes, as part of its curriculum, hobbies, both recreational and profitable depending on the child's interest. The hobbies also include indoor games such as Chess, Carrom, Rubik's Cube, etc.

Dance and music being a universal language and the platform upon which both Indian and Western culture rest, these too are arranged at the LPC with the belief that the child really becomes a global citizen of the world.

Special periods are allotted to each class to help the students learn various arts and crafts like photography, carpentry, painting, sketching etc.

12. Discipline

The LPC adheres to the philosophy of improvement, even in the troublesome child, through counselling and corrective measures and discourages any kind of corporal punishment.

The members of the LPC staff keep a keen vigil on the behaviour, manner and activities of each child. When they detect something unusual and disagreeing characteristic in a child they try to correct him taking recourse more to psychological ways. The LPC children are divided into four Houses with a view to creating a healthy competitive spirit in them. The School also has a six-student team comprising the School Captain, the Vice Captain and one office bearer from each of the houses to monitor the discipline among the students in the campus. In extreme cases the members of this team report the matter to the Principal or the Housemasters/Housemistress.

13. General

- (i) The medium of instruction in all classes is English. However, the LPC lays great emphasis on the learning and teaching of Hindi and has made it a compulsory subject for all the students till class X.
- (ii) The LPC has a co-educational system. The seats in each class are limited and registration/admission to various classes is done on the basis of the candidates performance in the LPC admission test and interview.
- (iii) The LPC has a prescribed uniform for all children and it is available with the authorized uniform suppliers.
- (iv) For admission of a child to LPC nursery class a child should not be less than three years and more than 4 years of age as on 1st April of the year when the admission is sought. For admission to other classes the child's age will be calculated accordingly.
- (v) Registration and admission shall be made on proper forms available from the School Office. A child for admission can be registered on a waiting list for any future academic session as desired by the guardian.
- (vi) Prior registration is a precondition for admission (registration fee is non-transferable and non-refundable). For registration of a child to LCP Nursery class, original birth certificate of the child from the Municipal authorities should be enclosed with the form. No affidavit will be accepted as proof of the child's age.
- (vii) For registration and admission to classes KG and above the original Transfer Certificate from the school last attended is required to be submitted within 30 days from the date of confirmation of admission. In case of a child still studying in a school and seeking admission in LPC is required to submit his certificate from the Principal of the School stating the child's date of birth, the class he is studying in and the year. However, if this formality

is not completed within thirty days from the date of confirmation, the admission shall stand cancelled.

- (viii) In case of a child's withdrawal in the mid-academic session a month's notice is essential. The month shall be deemed from the first to end or part of any month thereof.
- (ix) Students who attend the school even for one day in April and are withdrawn and are withdrawn for any reason will have to pay full fees upto September regardless of whether they take the T.C. or not (full fees includes all types of school charges and the tuition fees).
- (x) The LPC discourages any kind of concession in fees.
- (xi) School fees and other charges must be paid in cash in advance at the school fee counter in quarterly installments by the 10th of April, July, October and January.
- (xii) A prescribed fine shall be charged on late payment of fee, i.e. if it is paid after the 10th of the months specified in (xi). The name of the child will be struck off the roll if all the dues are not cleared by the last working day of that month. The children may, however, be re-enrolled on paying re-admission fees of Rs. 400.00 along with the arrears standing against the child.
- (xiii) In no case will the late payment fine or the re-admission be excused.
- (xiv) No deduction in any of the school charges will be allowed for holidays or the vacations.

14. Examinations

From the academic year which commences from 20th March 2024 the examination policy will be as follows:-

For Classes Nursery to V

There are no examinations from classes Nursery to V. In order to assess the comprehensive ability of the students, regular tests are held of 25 marks in all subjects in the months of July, September, December & February each summing upto 100 at the end of session.

For Classes VI and VII (ICSE)

Periodic tests contribute 10 marks and note book submission, subject enrichment activities contribute 10 marks. Thus total of 20 marks are added to Half Yearly examination from Periodic Test and 1 and to Final Examination from Periodic Test 2 to make a cumulative total of 100. It is compulsory to secure 40% marks in every subject in the Final Examination to be promoted to the Net class.

Class VIII duration of Half Yearly and Final Examination is three hours (only for CBSE).

For Classes VI and VII (CBSE)

Components and Weightage

1. Periodic Test: 10 marks each before half yearly and Final examination.
2. Notebook Submission & Subject Enrichment Activities: 10 marks.
3. Half Yearly Examination: 80 marks (written exam).
4. Final Examination: 80 marks (written exam).

Total Marks

- Half Yearly Examination: 100 marks (20 marks from Periodic Test 1 to 80 marks written exam)
- Final Examination: 100 marks (20 marks from Periodic Test 2 to 80 marks written exam)

Promotion Criteria

- Compulsory 40% in every subject in the Final Examination to be promoted to the next class.
Classes 6 to 8 -1.5hrs

Examination Duration

- Classes 6th & 7th: 2.5 hrs (both Half Yearly and Final Exams)
- Classes 8th: 3 hrs (both Half Yearly and Final Exams)

Subject Combinations

- English: English Language and English Literature (combined paper)
- Science: Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (combined paper)
- Social Studies: History, Civics, and Geography (combined paper)

For Classes VIII (CBSE)

Periodic tests contribute 10 marks and note book submission, subject enrichment activities contribute 10 marks. Thus total of 20 marks are added to Half Yearly examination from Periodic Test and 1 and to Final Examination from Periodic Test 2 to make a cumulative total of 100. It is compulsory to secure 40% marks in every subject in the Final Examination to be promoted to the net class.

Class VIII duration of Half Yearly and Final Examination is three hours.

For Classes VIII & IX (ICSE)

During the academic year there will be four examinations - Pre-quarterly examination, Quarterly examination, Half Yearly examination and Final examination. The three examination in the month of July, September and December will carry 20% weightage each, whereas the final examination of 40% weightage, will be summed up for making the final result and of 100 marks. It is essential to score 40% aggregate in every subject to be promoted to the next class.

For Classes IX & X (CBSE)

The assessment will have an 80 marks component for Board examination (Class X) and Final examination (Class IX) in all subjects along with a 20 marks all subject along with a 20 marks component of internal assessment for which best two out of Pre-Quarterly Examination, and Half yearly examination will contribute in addition to Note Book submission and subject enrichment activities to make a cumulative total of 100. It is compulsory to score 40% marks in every subject in class IX to be promoted to class X.

For class X, there will be a Pre-board examination tentatively in January 2025 to be eligible to appear in the Board Examination in March 2025.

For Classes XI (ICS) and XII (CBSE)

During the Academic year there will be a periodic test and three Examinations, Quarterly Examination, Half Yearly Examination and Final Examination in the months of August, September, December and February. The Examination of September and December will carry 20% weightage each, whereas the Final Final Examination in February will carry 60% weightage. The two examinations of 20% weightage each and Final Examination of 60% weightage will be summed up for making the final result out of 100 marks. It is essential to score 40% aggregate in every subject to be promoted to the next class.

For Class X (ICSE), XII (ISC) & XII (CBSE)

During the academic year there will be Four Examinations Pre Quarterly Examination, Quarterly Examination, Half Yearly Examination and Pre-Board Examination & 2 Unit Test for XII These examinations will be conducted in the months of July, September, December, January and the Board Examination as per schedule from the Board. Class X (ICSE) and XII (ISC) all the subject will have components for Internal Assessment on the basis of assignments/ project work, practicals and viva. These will be added to component of The Board Examination set and Conducted by the Council.

The Pre-Board Examination will be conducted in the month of January. It is essential for all the students to pass the Pre-Board to appear in the Board Examination in February 2025.

It is compulsory to pass the school conducted Pre-boards to appear in the board examination and a minimum attendance of 75%.

No student is allowed to carry his/her report card home. The parents are required to personally see and sign the card when they attend the parent teacher meeting at the end of each examination.

The report cards of every child will be kept in their personal files as long as he remains a student of the school. In this way we are able to maintain a complete record of the child's performance over the years. This system has been greatly appreciated by the board.

15. Private Tuitions

The LPC not only discourage private tuitions but also disapproves of it. Under no circumstances the school teachers are permitted to give private tuition to the LPC children. Children extremely weak in studies may be referred to the Principal for remedial help.

16. School Project

Since the LPC aims at excellence in education, the school employs all modern means and teaching techniques, such as linguaphone records, cassette records, overhead projectors, slide projectors, overhead speakers and closed circuit television, to realise this high goal. Besides class-room teaching, for all round development of the child, participation in various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities such as educational tours, short trips, debates, cultural functions has been made compulsory. Every child is invariably exposed to different life conditions. He is provided with such opportunities as will help him grow well and be successful in life.

A complete performance track record of every student is maintained, thereby enhancing their performance by developing a positive attitude in them.

ACCELERATED LEARNING ACTION PROGRAMME

The accelerated learning action plan is the programme of the Collegiate to equip the students with a positive mental setup to make learning more interesting and easy.

The Collegiate teaches each student to learn in their own preferred way—the way that suits their own brain—its like writing with one's own preferred hand. The result is much better, easier and quicker learning. This program teaches the students as to how they can discover and use their preferred way of learning to derive the required result. Hence, the programme promises not only to accelerate the student's learning capacity, but it makes learning easier, more effective and, above all, more enjoyable.

LPC CREDIT CARDS / STAR OF THE MONTH

This unique system of credit card has specially been designed to motivate the students of classes VI and above and to provide them direct reward instantly so that they can co-relate their hard work with the resultant reward and strive further for excellence.

It provides them with very short term goals which can be achieved with little effort but at the same time these short term goals form a part of the long term objectives of creating self esteem, responsibility, savings and a general and practical understanding of the socio-economic and commercial system so essential for one and all in today's world.

The children are awarded with points in their class tests which can be accumulated to buy credit cards which are available in four categories Platinum Z, Platinum, Gold and Silver for 500, 150, 75 and 25 points respectively. The students after buying the cards become members of the credit card club. The club has a credit shop and a bank. The bank is operated by the club in which the members can open a savings account or fixed deposit account and earn in erms of interest allowed by the bank twice a year in September and March.

LPC has designed a unique way of rewarding the junior students of class V and below by awarding them the title of star of the month. The star of the month is declared every month based upon the overall performance of a student for a particular month. The following points are considered for awarding for awarding the little on a monthly basis.

- i) Academic performance
- ii) Neatness
- iii) Discipline
- iv) Participation in co-curricular activities
- v) Participation in games

The students are awarded the title in the assembly and are given a badge which they wear for the entire month, thus developing in them self-esteem, confidence & self respect.

Residents : Boarding Facilities

Residential facilities are now available at LPC, Sharda Nagar, Lucknow for boys only of classes III onwards.

A matron and hostel superintendents are on duty round the clock. Each boarder is provided with a separate bed and personal locker. Articles, as per the list given are to be arranged by the parents/Guardians. Breakfast, evening snacks and dinner is provided to them separately while lunch is served along with day-boarders. All day to day necessities are taken care of by the superintendents who are directly answerable to the Joint Director/Principal.

Visiting Rules

Visiting hours for local guardians/parents of the boarders are from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on the 1st and the 4th Sunday of the month. A Border may be taken on the second Saturday and the second Sunday of the month and must report back either by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday or 8:00 a.m. the following Monday. NO unintroduced local guardian is either permitted to meet the boarder or to take him home.

In case the Parents/guardians wish to take the child/after/on a holiday, prior written permission from the Joint Director/Principal should be taken.
